Defense Leads Crusaders to Opening Victory

The Crusaders kicked of the 2014 football season on the right foot, with a 21-6 victory over the Pickerington North Panthers. Before the Moeller offense settled in, it was the Crusaders defense that caused havoc all night for the Panthers offense and senior QB Christian Whitner. The Crusaders defense lead by senior LB Mitch Brauning and junior LB John Griga, who combined for 15.5 tackles, held Pickerington North to 86 rushing yards on the evening. ArchbishopMoeller's got on the board in the late second quarter on a 25 touchdown reception by senior Chase Pankey from senior Matt Crable to take a 7-0 lead. The Crusaders added on to their lead midway through the 3rd quarter, as quarterback Matt Crable, ran it in from 14 yards out to extend the lead to 14. The key series of the night for the Crusaders defense came following a turnover in Big Moe's territory in the late 3rd quarter. The Crusaders kept the Panthers off the scoreboard following agoal line stand, that saw Pickerington North have a 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th and goal from inside Archbishop Moeller's 10 yard line. The Crusaders added a final score early in the 4th quarter on a 4 yard run by junior Demetrius Yett. The Panthers got on the board late in the 4th guarter on a 41 yard reception by Jaye Williams to tally the 21-6 final. The Crusaders junior kick Matt Coghlin moved into 8th all-time for career kicking points leaders at Archbishop Moeller with his 3 extra points. Coghlin now sits alone with 100 career points.

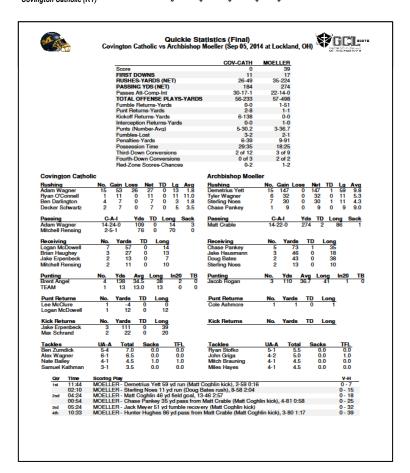

Defense Dominates Again in Shut-Out

Lockland, OH ~ Big Moe continued their success against Covington Catholic and extended its winning streak dating back to the 2013 season to 8 games by blanking the Colonels, 39-0. The Crusaders took control right out the gate, when junior Demetrius Yett took it 59 yards on the second play of the game to give the Crusaders a 7-0 lead. CovCath's best scoring chance of the night came with 8:41 left to go in the first quarter after a Sterling Noes fumble. The Colonels had the ball inside the Crusaders 10 yard line, but were unable to move it any closer on 4 downs. The Crusaders added on to their lead on a 11 yard rush by Noes and a 2 point conversation by Doug Bates, late in the first quarter to jump out to a 15-0 lead. The Crusaders added a 46 yard field goal by junior Matt Coghlin midway through the 2nd quarter to extend the lead to 18-0. The final scoring of the first half came when Matt Crable connected with Chase Pankey for a 35 yard touchdown pass to send the Crusaders into the locker room up 25-0. The Crusaders would add two more scores in the second

half. One came when Jack Meyer picked up a CovCath fumble and scampered 51 yards for the score and the other came on a 86 yard touchdown reception from Crable to sophomore Hunter Hughes for the final 39-0 tally. Archbishop Moeller's defense was stellar again, allowing only 233 total yards all night and only 49 on the ground. Big Moe was led on defense by junior John Griga who had 5 tackles and senior Mitch Brauning who had 4.5. Senior cornerback, Noah Able added an interceptioon in addition to his 4 tackles. The Crusaders junior kick Matt Coghlin moved into 6th all-timefor career kicking points leaders at Archbishop Moeller with his 4 extra points and field goal Coghlin now sits

alone with 107 career points.

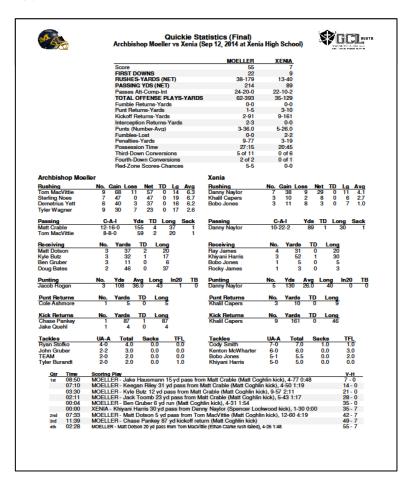

Xenia, OH ~ The Crusaders traveled north to take on the Buccaneers and came back with a resounding,55-7 victory. The Crusaders took control from theiropening offensive drive and never looked back. 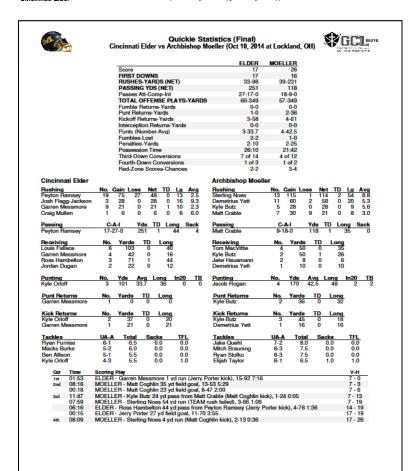



COMPETITIVE BALANCE

A discussion that began 35 years ago, but has gained more traction in recent years, finally moved in a new direction May 16 with the announcement by the Ohio High School Athletic Association of the passage of a competitive balance proposal.



The state's high school principals voted to accept a new plan intended to level the playing field between public and private schools, allowing the OHSAA to modify how schools are placed in tournament divisions in eight team sports, including football. (other team sports are to boys' soccer, basketball and baseball and girls' soccer, volleyball, basketball and softball.)

In the past, enrollment has been the only factor in deciding a team's division for post-season tournament play. For football, the division was determined by the number of incoming 10th, 11th and 12th grade boys.

Under the newly passed rules, a formula is applied to each athlete on the roster, based on where his parents reside, the history of his school enrollment, or both. A correlating number — zero, one or two — will be assigned to each player and multiplied by a sport factor (for football it is 2), which differs for the various sports governed by the new rules. In the end, an adjusted enrollment number is created.

For Ohio's parochial schools, the administration of the school can designate ONE feeder parish in which all players from that parish count will not count in adjusted enrollment figure (those players are given a factor of 0). Those athletes outside that parish, but enrolled in the same educational system (for Catholic grade schools, it is the specific Diocesan approved feeder schools) since seventh grade count as a factor of one All others will count as two when calculating enrollment.

Member schools will report roster figures during training camp, along with the first week and third week of the football season. Those additional roster counts will be added to the initial enrollment figures to determine an adjusted enrollment number.

After the adjustment enrollment numbers are confirmed, division assignments will be created and announced – probably in week 4 of the high school football season.

This proposal passed by a margin of 411-323 with three abstentions. The formal proposal takes effect during the 2016-17 school-year, although a pilot program will be developed and completed during the 2015-16 year.

Similar plans have been voted down three times in the last few years. Member schools defeated plans to create separate championship tournaments for public and private schools in 1978 and 1993.

NEW OHSAA TIMING RULES

For years, high school football games in Ohio could be shortened by mutual agreement of both head coaches. That will change this fall with the adoption of a football point differential rule as part of the 2014-15 sport regulations approved by the Ohio High School Athletic Association Board of Directors.

The point differential regulation, which is already used in many states, is permitted by state adoption according to the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS).

Beginning this fall, when a football point differential reaches 30 points or more after the first half, the clock will only be stopped during an official's timeout, a charged timeout, the end of a period or after a score. The clock will continue to run in all other situations

After the 30-point difference has been met, if the margin drops below 30 points, the clock reverts to regular timing.

Quarters still may be shortened in an emergency by agreement of the coaches and referee.

The proposal was recommended by the OHSAA staff after more than a year of consultation with the Ohio High School Football Coaches Association. Unlike changes to the bylaws and constitution, which require a vote of the membership, changes to sport-specific regulations and the general sports regulations need only approval from the OHSAA board of directors.

CRUSADERS WITH NEW CLOCK RULE

The Crusaders have been in 2 game this season (Covington Catholic (KY), W 39-0 and Xenia, W 55-7 that the new 30 pt running clock rule was put into effect.

TOUGH SLEDDING

Archbishop Moeller recorded it's seventh game of the season against Miamisburg in which they allowed 100 yard rushing or less in a game. The Crusaders have held two straight opponents under the century mark in rushing, with only allowing 56 yards on the ground against Louisville Trinity and only allowing 100 yards versus Miamisburg. ON THE MONEY

In addition holding the school record for kicking points in a career, junior Matt Coghlin has been amongst the best kickers in Ohio. Coghlin in his two years as the Crusaders kicker has connected on 22 of 30 field goals (73.3%) and has missed one extra point in going 94 for 95 (98.9%). Coghlin has been extremely impressive from 35 yards and beyond by connecting on 9 of 16 (56.25%) field goals in two years.

CASHING IN ON TURNOVERS

Archbishop Moeller has taken advantage this season of forced turnovers by turning them into points. Archbishop Moeller has forced 16 turnovers this season have turned them into 55 points. Archbishop Moeller has also kept opposing teams off the scoreboard, when the Crusaders turn it over, by allowing only 30 points on 15 turnovers.

GETTING OPPONENTS OFF THE FIELD

The Crusaders defense has been very good this season, by keeping opponents from converting 3rd and 4th downs.
