

VARSITY BOWLING INFORMATION

Beginning of Season – 11/01/19

Tryouts will be the first week of November

Friday, November 1st; Monday, November 4th; Tuesday, November 5th

All participants must bowl a minimum of 4 games and a max of 6 games

Open Bowling – 3:30pm – 5:00pm (During September)

Students are not required, but are encouraged to utilize open bowling times at Eastern. This would be a great time to practice before tryouts begin.

Open Conditioning – 3:30pm – 5:00pm (During October)

These are not required but are encouraged.

Students can also use this time to get bowling balls, other bowling accessories necessary for the season.

The last preseason date for conditioning is next ***Tuesday, October 29th***

JV and Varsity – AT MOST 8 spots

Assuming there is enough interest, both the men and women teams will have a Varsity and Junior Varsity team. Teams will have a maximum of 8 players, with certain students (potentially) having the ability to float between teams.

This sport may cut if the number of signups ***exceed 16 students***

If there is not enough interest (***less than 16***), there may only be a Varsity OR Junior Varsity teams.

Practices, Matches, and Tournaments

Attendance – Practices will take place multiple days and on a weekly basis. Students should attend the majority of all practices and matches. If students do not attend, their play time during matches and tournaments will be directly affected.

Small Practices – This year some of our practices will be considered “small practices” where we ONLY work with JV or Varsity. Please pay attention to the schedule as to when you need to attend.

Ride Sharing – If students are unable to drive/need a ride somewhere, please organize something amongst the team or other families (always check with parents)! Lack of a ride is NOT an excusable absence for practice/matches/tournaments.

Matches/Tournaments – There will be numerous matches and 2 – 3 tournaments during this season. The schedule is posted at fenwicksports.org under team (bowling). This information will also be available on the team site.

Polos/Jerseys

At matches, students should wear the required bowling polo with their school khaki pants or skirts. Until the jerseys are ordered and in, students should wear their school polo.

Students not in the correct uniform will not be able to play during matches.

Shoe and Bowling Balls

Eastern has a program that provides free bowling balls to high school students that need one. The only requirement is that we submit a roster and indicate which student-athlete is requesting a ball. Families may be responsible for a nominal fee to get holes drilled specifically for their kid's hand.

Bowling shoes are typically available at the alley if you don't have your own
