Bowling Green State University - Science and Math Education in ACTION offers recipients \$4,000 the first year of college with increases each year up to more than \$5,000 the fourth year - a scholarship valued at a total of approximately \$20,000 (based on continued state funding) High school seniors considering teaching either secondary science or math, OR middle childhood science and math may be eligible for this scholarship program. The basic criteria for consideration includes: Ohio resident, incoming freshman Fall 2018, min. GPA of 3.0, Minimum ACT of 23 and considering a career teaching science and/or mathematics.
DEADLINE to apply Jan. 15, 2018

General Electric Credit Union Robert A. Cunningham Memorial Scholarship - Five students will be awarded with a one-time scholarship of \$2,000. These scholarships are worth at least \$10,000 when renewed over 4 yrs. They are awarded to first-year, full-time students who enroll in a four-year program in any major within the Department of Art and Design. The department offers Bachelor of Fine arts degree programs in Art Education, Fine Arts Studio, Photography and Graphic Design and Bachelor of Arts in Art History and Visual Arts. Mensa Education and Research Foundation - Students who are U.S. citizens or permanent residents and who will be enrolled in accredited colleges for the following academic year may apply. Applicants are required to submit an essay (up to 550 words) explaining their career, academic and/or vocational goals and how they plan to achieve those goals. Grades, academic program and/or financial need are not included in the final determination of scholarship recipients. Awards range from \$300 to \$2,500. Application deadline is Jan. 15, 2018. Wilberforce Freshman Scholarships - Applicants that have SAT/ACT scores and transcripts on file with the Office of Admissions will automatically be considered for Wilberforce University scholarships. The following criteria must be met for eligibility for academic scholarships: confirmation to attend Wilberforce by April 30th, U.S. citizenship or permanent residence, completion of FAFSA, be a first-time college or university attendee (exclude dual enrollment or early college programs) Available scholarships:

- **Presidential Excellence**- scholarship amount is tuition, fees, room board and books. Required 1200 on the SAT or 26 ACT, 4.0 gpa required, enroll and earn a min. of 15 credit hours per semester, and apply for Financial Aid
- **Board of Trustees**- \$12,000, required test scored 1000 on the SAT or 21 ACT, 3.75 GPA required and enroll in and earn a min. of 15 credit hours per semester, and apply for financial aid.
- **Wilberforce Bulldog**- \$6,000, required 1000 on SAT or 21 ACT, 3.75 GPA required, enroll in and earn a min. Of 15 credit hours per semester, and apply for financial aid.
- **Wilberforce Academic**- \$3,000, required test 810 on the SAT or 17 ACT, 3.25 GPA required and enroll in and earn a min. Of 15 credit hours per semester, and apply for financial aid.

AFSCME Family Scholarship - Each year the AFSCME Family Scholarship Program provides \$2,000 scholarships to high school seniors that will renew for \$2,000 each year for a maximum of 4 years, provided the student remains enrolled in a full-time course of study. The scholarship may be used for any field of study. To be eligible, you must be a graduating senior whose parent, legal guardian or financially responsible grandparent is a AFSCME member paying dues. When the scholarship is awarded, be enrolled in a full-time degree program either at an accredited four-year institution or at a 2 year institution that will transfer credits to a 4 year institution and have taken the SAT or the ACT. OAPSE/AFSCME Memorial Scholarship - this scholarship is available to any high school graduating senior whose parent or legal guardian is a member in good standing of the Ohio Association of Public School Employees (OAPSE/AFSCME Local 4/AFL-CIO) and who intends to enroll in a full-time degree program in any 2 or 4 year accredited university, college, business or technical school. The scholarships may be used for any field of study. \$2500 scholarships are awarded to the winners selected from the applications who meet the eligibility requirements.
