Removal or Dismissal From Team

Any Cheerleader, who is removed, dismissed or quits the team will not be permitted to participate for the following year. This also includes a cheerleader trying out and quitting the team once she has already made the roster.

Administrative Disciplinary Actions

OSS (Out of School Suspension for 4 days or more)

First Offense- IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL FROM TEAM

OSS/ISS (Out of School or In School Suspension for 3 days or less)

First Offense- Athlete may not practice or participate on the days/dates of the suspension, but are still required to be present.

Parent is notified by mail/e-mail that the next suspension will result in dismissal from the team.

* Additional coach administered discipline may be administered including dismissal from the team. **Second Offense-** Student is dismissed from the team.

Administrative Detention/ After School Detention

First Offense- Parent is notified by mail/ e-mail that additional administrative detentions could result in dismissal from the team. Additional coach administered discipline will be taken which could include reduced playing time in a game.

Second Offense- Parent is notified by mail/e-mail that the next administrative discipline actions will result in dismissal from the team. Additional coach administered discipline will be taken which could include reduced playing time in a game.

Third Offense- Student is dismissed from the team

3 Unexcused Absences = Removal from team
3 Unexcused Tardies = 1 Absence
1 Unexcused Absence from game or performance

= Removal from team

ANY COMBINATION OF THREE VIOLATIONS WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL FROM THE TEAM. THE ADMINISTRATION RESERVES THE RIGHT TO WAIVE ALL OF THE ABOVE STEPS AND DISMISS AN ATHLETE FROM A TEAM.
